Regulations

Swiss system , 9 rounds Open Tournament - reported to FIDE,

For players with a FIDE RAPID rating of at least 2000, in case of absence of a RAPID ranking player FIDE rating must be at least 2000.

Organizer reserves the right to admit several players not meeting the ranking criterion, the Organizer also reserves the right to lower the ranking threshold, but not lower than 1800 FIDE.

Time control: 10 minutes per game per player plus 5 seconds added after each move.

The place taken is determined by: number of points, auxiliary points: Buchholz-Cut1 (BHC1), Buchholz (BH), Sonnenborn-Berger (SB), progress (PS), higher FIDE ranking.

Maximum delay allowed for a round: 10 minutes.

FIDE rules of the game apply to this tournament.

In the e-mail application, please provide your name, surname, club or town, chess category/title and full date of birth.

Applications until June 24. Maximum of 100 participant can play.

Applications will be published on the starting lists on an ongoing basis along with confirmation of receipt of the competitor's entry fee (please do not send transfer confirmations). Confirmation of acceptance of the application is the inclusion of the competitor on the list of applications on the tournament websites indicated in point. Likewise, confirmation of a competitor's resignation from participation in the competition is his removal from the entry list.

Players with the note "OK" (or similar) on the entry list do not have to confirm their presence in the playing hall, but should be present at the technical briefing.

Entry fee

The entry fee is PLN 80, GM / WGM / IM / WIM – exempt from the entry fee

Payment of the entry fee only by bank transfer by June 24 (the date of receipt to the account is decisive, please do not send transfer confirmations). **On June 25, competitors without paid entry fees will be removed from the starting lists. The entry fee paid is non-refundable.**
